

Items Accepted

Clothing: For the April 2009 sale, we will accept girls' and boys' spring/summer seasonal clothing and shoes. We now accept sizes newborn to size 16 (junior sizes no longer accepted). Clothing must be in excellent condition, with no stains or holes. All buttons, snaps, and zippers must work. Clothing style should be less than 5 years old. Recommended pricing is 1/4 - 1/3 of the original price.

Maternity: Current style maternity clothing will be accepted. The recommended pricing for items is 1/4 - 1/3 of the original price. Clothing must be in excellent condition, with no stains or holes.

Shoes: Must be clean and in excellent condition.

Toys: Must be in excellent condition. Toys must have working batteries. Small pieces should be in sealed bags and taped shut. Please check to see that toys have not been recalled (www.cpsc.gov/index.html).

Books/DVDs/Videos/CDs: Books should be free of tears and writing. Books on pregnancy are accepted. Please make sure that all media items work with no skipping.

Baby equipment: Must be in excellent condition. Play pens, strollers, high chairs, bouncy seats, exersaucers, and booster seats are examples of acceptable items. **ONLY** infant car seats that are part of a stroller system will be accepted. Recommended pricing is 1/3 - 1/2 of the original price. Make sure that items have not been recalled. Older items that do not meet safety standards (i.e., crib slats are spaced too wide, etc.) will not be accepted.

Outdoor play equipment: Must be in excellent condition. Examples are bikes, trikes, scooters, ride-ons, playsets, wagons, and sports equipment.

Furniture: Must be in excellent condition. Examples are toddler beds, bureaus, toy chests, cribs, changing tables, desks, rocking chairs, gliders, and twin-size headboards.

Bedding/décor: Anything child-related.

Items NOT Accepted

- ❖ Stuffed animals, unless they require batteries
- ❖ Car seats/booster seats, unless it is an infant seat with a stroller system that is less than 5 years old
- ❖ Bike helmets
- ❖ Bottle nipples & pacifiers
- ❖ Underwear, unless package is new & unopened
- ❖ Diapers, unless package is new & unopened
- ❖ Potty seats & diaper pails
- ❖ R-rated movies/anything not age-appropriate

Donor Drop-off Instructions to Benefit the Co-op (The Cooperative Playschool)

1. Register with the Co-op by emailing debhuckans@yahoo.com or by calling 814.238.2351.
2. Check that items have not been recalled (www.cpsc.gov/index.html).
3. Drop items off (with hangers, if possible) at the Co-op during the drop-off hours under **"Co-op Sale Schedule"** OR call Deb Huckans to schedule a pick up (814.238.2351).
4. Items should be clean, have all pieces present, and have no holes or stains. Any unacceptable items will be donated to a local charity of the Co-op's choice.
5. Make sure to read "Items Not Accepted."
6. Your generous donations to the Co-op become the sole property of the Co-op for its exclusive use and benefit. All net proceeds, as well as all rejected or unsold items resulting from donations, become the sole property of the Co-op for its discretionary use.

Tagging Instructions for Co-op Tagging Party (see "Co-op Sale Schedule")

Items needed (provide them if possible):

- 3 x 5 index cards
- hangers
- pen and masking tape
- ziplock bags
- safety pins (1" or longer)
- clear packing tape

Please follow instructions:

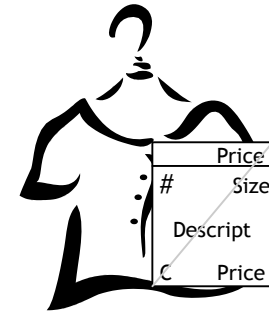
Writing tags:

- ❖ Use a 3 x 5 index card for each item. Please use the card vertically, with the blank side up.
- ❖ Write the price in the upper right corner. **Minimum price is \$2.00.** Combine lower ticket items to meet that price. All prices are in dollar increments.
- ❖ Draw line 1 ½ inches below the top of card.
- ❖ Write your **consignor number** in the left corner, immediately below the line.
- ❖ Write the clothing size in the right corner, immediately below the line. **Only** maternity items can be sized using S/M/L/XL. Children's clothing needs to be numbered (6 mo, 2T).
- ❖ Write a description of the item in the middle of the card (i.e., brand, type of item).
- ❖ Write the price again in the lower right corner.
- ❖ Write a "C" for charity in the lower left corner if you want your unsold items to be donated to a charity after the sale.
- ❖ **Most important:** Draw a slash line from the upper right corner to the bottom left corner with a pink or yellow highlighter pen if your item should be sold at **half price** on the second public sale day. No slash will mean that your item will be sold only at **full price**.

Hanging clothing:

- ❖ The hanger hook should face left.
- ❖ When hanging a two-piece outfit, hang the shirt on the hanger and attach the skirt/pants to the back of the shirt using two large safety pins at the shoulder seams. Or hang each item on separate hangers and tie the hangers together.
- ❖ When putting several shirts/skirts/pants together, use the same method as above. Sleepers/onesies can be prepared this way as well. Remember the minimum price for items is \$2.00, so group lower ticket items.

Tagging Instructions cont'd



Attaching tags to clothing:

- ❖ Safety pin tag to the upper right of the garment when looking at the front. Please use 1" safety pins or larger, inserting them through the tags and garments horizontally (right to left).

Preparing non-hanging items:

- ❖ All items should be clean, in good condition, and have all parts.
- ❖ Toys requiring batteries must have working batteries for the sale.
- ❖ Toys with small parts should be bagged, with clear packing tape sealing the top.
- ❖ For large toys with small parts, bag smaller items and attach to larger toy with tape.
- ❖ Books/videos/DVDs/CDs should be placed in plastic bags.
- ❖ Shoes must be in excellent condition. Tie the laces together or use string.
- ❖ Small items such as bibs, hair bows, bottles, socks, etc. should be bagged. Seal the top of the bag with clear packing tape.
- ❖ Remember the minimum price is \$2.00 for items, so feel free to group items together.

Attaching tags to non-hanging items:

- ❖ **Shoes:** Pin the sale tag through the shoelaces or attach it with string.
- ❖ **Toys:** For toys in plastic bags, pin the sale tag through the bag. For unbagged toys, use clear packing tape on the upper part of the tag (above the drawn line). Be sure the lower part of the tag can be cut off.
- ❖ **Books/videos:** If the item is bagged, pin the tag through the bag. If the item is unbagged, use only masking tape to attach the top part of the tag.
- ❖ For other small bagged items, pin the sale tag through the bag.
